Hosted on ranches in the Big Bend region of Texas, the 2024 Sul Ross State University Archaeological Field School will teach participants archaeological field and laboratory methods to prepare students for careers in archaeology. Students will learn necessary skills for conducting *block excavation, testing, pedestrian survey, and rock art recording*, while also learning *data management* and how to *process artifacts and samples*. This year's field school will focus efforts around Spirit Eye Cave and the 13,000-year-old Genevieve-Lykes Duncan Site. **Field School is limited to 10 students.**
