## ANTH 3601 – Summer I Archeological Field School

June 1<sup>st</sup> – July 6<sup>th</sup>

The Center for Big Bend Studies of Sul Ross State University will offer an introductory archaeology field school at the San Esteban Rockshelter near Marfa, Texas. The course will consist of 3 – consecutive 10 day sessions in a remote field setting. This is a rare chance to work at a dry rockshelter in gorgeous West Texas.

The course will introduce students to archaeological excavation techniques in a complex dry rock shelter setting, photogrammetric mapping methods, and other fundamentals of archaeological fieldwork. The course will require students to camp in a remote desert setting and we will work closely with a crew of researchers from the University of Kansas.

In-state Tuition: \$1,791.38 *\*\*A \$500.00 additional field fee is required to cover the cost of food and transportation.*  
Out-of-state Tuition: \$4,245.38
